



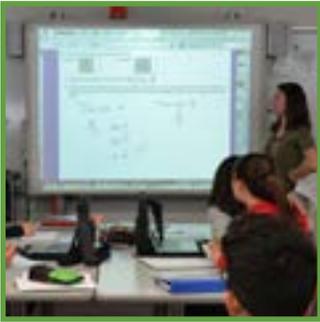
Avoca School District 37 Technology Innovation Plan: 2017-2021 Implementation Schedule
